The management of the college shall follow the regulations made by the University / State Government in making admissions, in conducting examinations and in respect of all other related matters from time to time. Any deviation in this regard may lead to withdrawal of affiliation to the college without any notice.

I am desired to refer to your letter dated 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2001 accepting the conditions contained in the Letter Of Intent issued by this Ministry on 25.4.2001 and to convey the formal Permission of the Central Government under section 10A (4) of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 to Sibar Educational Academy, Vijayawada, A.P., to establish a new dental college, 'Sibar Institute of Dental Sciences', at Takkellapadu, Peddakakani M.L., Dist.: Guntur, A.P., with an annual intake capacity of 40 students from the academic Session 2001-2002.

2. This Permission is granted for a period of one year, i.e., for admitting only one batch of students during the academic session 2001-2002 and will be renewed on yearly basis after verification of the achievements of the annual targets and revalidation of the Performance Bank Guarantee given by your Society for Rs.75 lakhs.

3. The admission for 2<sup>nd</sup> batch will be made only after renewal of Permission by the Central Government. Admissions made in violation of this condition will be treated as irregular and action under Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 will be initiated.
