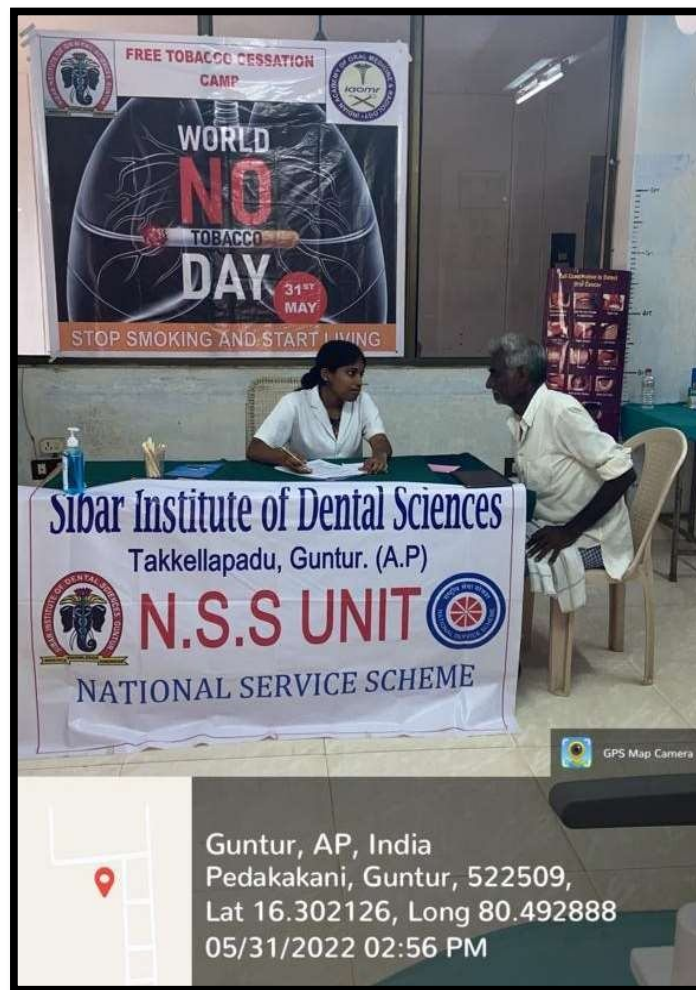

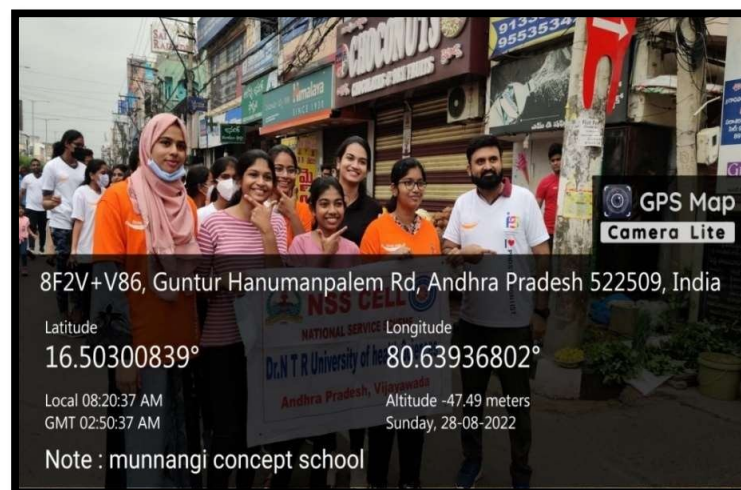

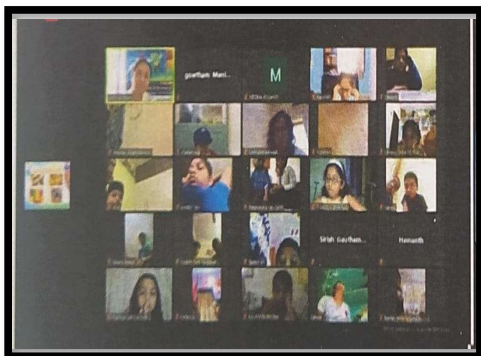
'ORAL HEALTH PROGRAMS VIA ONLINE PLATFORM'

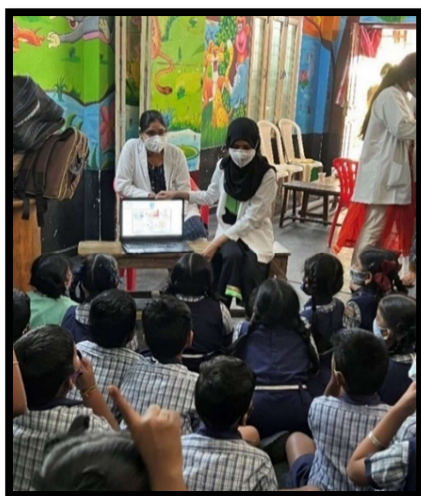
